- Thanks to the commitment of the 80 university and school members of AROQA for their continuous support to developing the Arab Organization for Quality Assurance in Education
- We witness today growing interests of Arab NRENs for joining ASREN as shareholders with Lebanon becoming an active partner in research and education networking.
- ASREN will continue to serve the Arab region in developing best practice NREN model and provide pan-Arab e-Infrastructure connectivity at the regional level. We have been supporting the NREN development in the Arab countries.
- We build on the operational success of ASREN's operational point of exchange in London. This point of exchange is now connected to the European GEANT network and to the rest of the World's research and education network. ASREN's PoP is linking a number of Arab NRENs for direct peering for research and education, now in the pursuit of Africa Connect 2 and EUMEDCONNECT3.
- Africa Connect 2 will create the first Pan-African Research and Education infrastructure coordinated by the African networking organizations: Arab States Research and Education Network (ASREN), West and Central African Research and Education Network (WACREN), and UbuntuNet Alliance, in partnership with the European counterpart GÉANT. The objective is to establish a largely EU co-funded project to provide high-speed Internet to African research and education.
- We announce today:
  - the launch of the 1 Giga bits per second Lebanese international research and education link via the American University of Beirut to the European GEANT via ASREN PoP. This build on a long planning and discussion with AUB and other partners in Lebanon including the national council for scientific research - CNRS
  - the launch of the 155 Mega bits per second STM1 Palestine international research and education link to be established via the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research to the European GEANT via ASREN PoP
  - the continuation of Jordan's 155 Mega bits per second STM1 link which now links the SESAME project and soon the Jordan University of Science and Technology

- continuing coordination with UbuntuNet Alliance to interconnect the Sudan Research and Education Network to the European Research and Education Network
- last and most important, our continuing coordination with the League of Arab States to establish the “Pan-Arab Connect”, a long-term Gigabit Ring interconnection with all the Arab Countries and with Europe and the world

We are very thankful to the European Commission for their great support, without their continuing co-funding, these interconnections would not have been possible.

- It has become necessary to establish high speed networks with Gigabits bandwidth connecting neighboring countries in the Arab region, and to the world regional networks for research and education
- This will help to introduce tools for developing collaboration and cooperation between scientists, researchers and students and to enhance the quality of education and research
- We announce the development of inter-operational platforms and success deployment of Eduroam in more than 10 countries in the Arab region

Excellencies, Ladies and Gentlemen,

- The Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Organization, the global professional service company which I established in 1972 will continue to support research and education in an effort to assist in the development of a broader and more inclusive information society in the Arab world. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh University is a new development towards democratizing world class education based on the provision of science, learning and creativity to the citizens of the world through educational partnership with the top 500 prestigious international universities
- We support developing quality of education through the Arab Organization for Quality Assurance in Education – AROQA. This year’s AROQA’s 8<sup>th</sup> Annual conference held today focuses on quality standards and accreditation.

Excellencies, Ladies and Gentlemen,

- Today and tomorrow, there will be intensive discussions from experts on research and education, from which we can derive important ideas for implementation. But I thought to share with you our plans and thoughts, which may be considered as recommendations, hoping to be the subject of study and as important declarations of this conference:
  1. Expand and develop a framework of effective participation of Arab NRENs towards developing a pan-Arab electronic infrastructure that strengthens the role of research and education communities in the Arab world.
  2. We want to move to a new phase in developing a road map for the Pan-Arab eInfrastructure building on EUMEDCONNECT3 and Africa Connect 2
  3. Launch an Arab-African awareness campaign that covers: the Concept of e-Infrastructure and connectivity, What Services and applications as well as benefits it provides, and How does it work in a best practice setup.
  4. Begin to invest in developing cross border links between Arab NRENs, to help support collaboration between the Arab scientists and move towards innovation and creative scientific communities
  5. Support sustainable pan-Arab research and education network connecting European and world leading regional networks
  6. Leverage and build on the previous success of the Euro-Mediterranean projects and forums in the field and the development of cooperation and coordination between the Arab and European researchers, and support joint scientific research projects that use the scientific infrastructures
  7. Work to encourage and attract donors and institutions supporting Arab research institutions to help in the development of the pan-Arab research and education network

8. Promote private sector participation and cooperation towards the development of research communities in variety of domains.
9. The League of Arab States has accepted to host the 7<sup>th</sup> international platform on integrating Arab e-Infrastructure in a Global Environment – eAGE 2017, the 9<sup>th</sup> annual conference of the Arab Organization for Quality Assurance in Education - AROQA 2017 in December 2017. We will coordinate our efforts with the Egyptian Universities Network for the continuation of our coordination next year.
